Parishioners are being asked to bring in a number of foodstuffs in support of the Archdiocese's St. Cyril of White Lake Food Pantry located at Holy Assumption Church on the Southside. The types of foods requested are the following:

Ready to eat canned fruit or vegetables	noodle/rice mixes small package of rice or
peanut butter	noodles
jelly	canned stews
soups	canned or pouches of tuna, salmon or
chili	chicken
macaroni & cheese	boxed meals ready to be prepared
spaghetti sauce	canned & boxed 100% juice

Bags of the above should be labeled 'Feed the Hungry Project' and left in the Social Hall on the last table on the left side as you enter from the Vestibule Steps. Please be generous, as the Lord reminds us: "for I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink." *Mt. 25:35.*

Special Prayer from the Passion Akafist

O Lord, Jesus Christ, Son of the Living God, Creator of heaven and earth, Savior of the world. Behold, I who am unworthy and of all people most sinful, humbly having bowed the knee of my heart before the glory of Your majesty, do praise Your Cross and Passion, and offer thanksgiving to You, the King and God of all, for that You were well-pleased to bear as man all hardship and every calamity, misfortune and torture, that You might be our fellow-suffering Helper and Savior, to everyone of us in all sorrows, wants and vexations. I know, O Omnipotent Master, that all these things were not necessary for You, but for the sake of the salvation of mankind, did You endure the Cross and the suffering of the enemy. How then shall I repay You, O You who loves mankind, for all that You have suffered for the sake of me, a sinner? I know not, for soul and body and all goodness comes from You, and all that is mine is Yours and I am Yours. Trusting solely to Your infinite compassion, O most gracious Lord, I praise Your unspeakable long-suffering. I magnify Your unutterable humiliation. I glorify Your immeasurable mercy, I worship Your all pure Passion and most lovingly embrace Your wounds and cry: *have mercy on me a sinner and grant that Your Holy Cross may not be fruitless in me*, that by participating with your faith in Your suffering, I may become worthy to behold also Your glory of the Kingdom in the Heavens.*

*It is suggested that you say this prayer daily during Lent and then on Friday of each week.
