Feast Day of the Holy Prophet Moses

Moses was a great leader and lawgiver of Israel. He was born in Egypt in about 1550 B.C. He spent forty years in Egypt at Pharaoh's court, forty years as a shepherd in meditation on God and the world, and his last forty years he led the people through the wilderness to the Promised Land, which he saw but did not enter, having at one time sinned against God (*Numbers 20:12*). He entered into rest at the age of a hundred and twenty. He appeared from the other world on Tabor at the Lord's Transfiguration, and according to the testimony of St. John of the Ladder, appeared to the monks of Sinai.
