Twelve years ago, Holy Resurrection began a Prayer Network to offer extra prayers for members of our Parish and their friends. This network is still functioning and very active. If anyone is interested in praying for those who request additional prayers plus those on the weekly candle list, please see Fran Sabo so that a prayer booklet and procedures can be prepared for your use.

Also if you want to request prayers for a loved one, please see Fran Sabo or complete a prayer request form that can be found on the book rack in the back of the church. Only first names are needed for prayers. These forms will be collected each Sunday and the names of your loved one(s) will be added to the prayer network on Monday. Also be aware that, for as long as a person is on the Network list, Father commemorates them by placing a particle of bread in their name on the Paten at the Proskomedia. He also mentions them by name at the Great Entrance during Divine Liturgy. Alternatively, the weekly candle list names are mentioned within the Divine Liturgy at the Litany of Fervent Supplication. This way the needs of all are consecrated into the Body of Christ at the Church's Eucharistic celebration, and the names of those in need are publically mentioned for the whole Church's prayerful consideration.
